Merging medicine and dentistry

Abstract: Today more than ever the pediatric practice is seeing children as early as a few days after birth and as old as teenagers for a variety of problems due to abnormal oral structures. Tethered oral tissues such as lip, cheek and tongue ties can interfere with many newborn and infant developmental conditions. Included in them are the ability to successfully breastfeed, air induced reflux, sleep apnea, mother –infant bonding, failure to thrive and for the mother mastitis, plugged ducts, thrush, nipple pain and post-partum depression. Oral surgery on infants can safely and quickly be completed in the dental office using lasers with little or no complications. This discussion will include the use of lasers in treating, oral surgery, traumatic injuries, as well as the diagnosis and treatment of a variety of soft tissue surgeries for infants, toddlers and older
